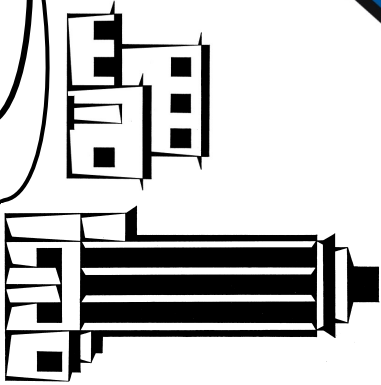

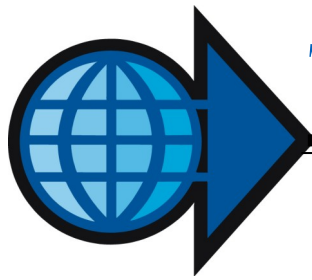

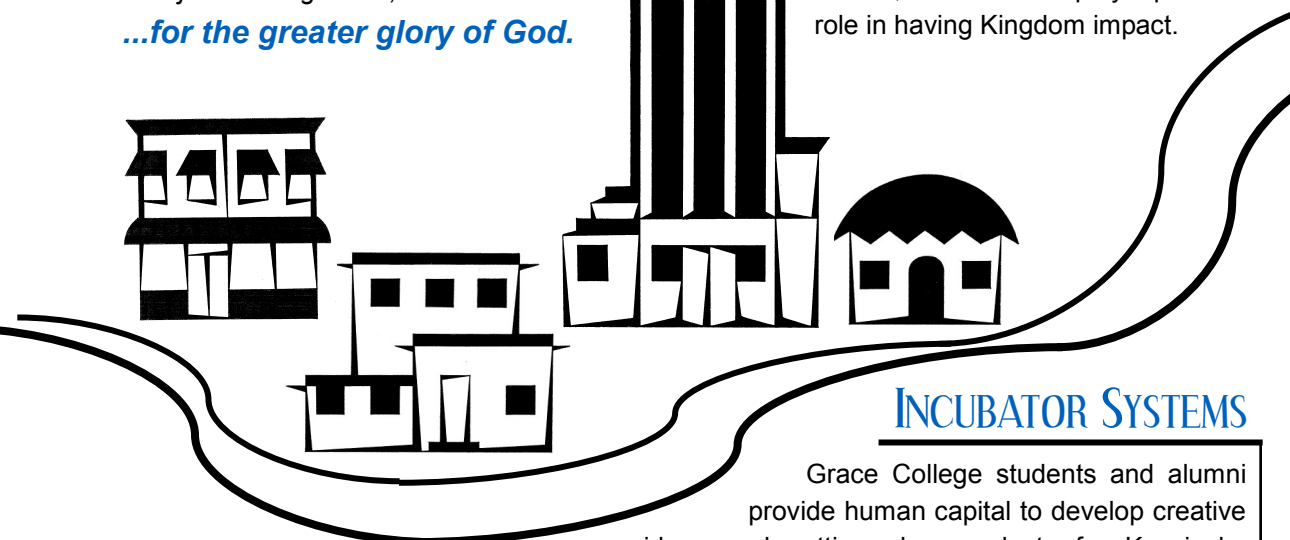
KINGDOM IMPACT
